Judging will be held on Tuesday, June 25, 2019 at the Wyandot County Fairgrounds beginning at 4:00 p.m. You can sign up on 4-H Online for a time to be judged or call the Extension Office for a time. If you have more than one project please allow at least 15-20 minutes between projects. Projects will be judged at the discretion of the Judge if a member is excessively late. There will be signs in the buildings to direct you to your judging area. Please refer to your project book and the [2019 Project Completion Guide](#) for specific judging guidelines.

**Clothing & Style Revue Information**

The Style Review will be part of your judging. **Style Revue will be on Thursday, June 27 at 7:00 p.m.** After your project is judged, you will be asked to model your outfit for the judge(s). Bring any information, at this time, needed to complete the Style Revue Card.

After being judged, take your score sheet to the grading table to be recorded and to receive your ribbon.
