

# Horse Exhibit

## Livestock Birth Dates, Possession Dates, and Jr. Fair Classes for the 2018 Wyandot County Fair

- Horses must be in exhibitor's possession by June 1.
- Interview judging will be at the discretion of the Ohio State University Extension Office.
- All Junior Fair horse and pony exhibitors must show his or her own project. Horses/ponies **cannot** be "shared" by exhibitors.
- There is **no limit on the number of classes** an exhibitor can enter.
- The **number of horses is limited** to no more than two horses or combination of horses and ponies per exhibitor.
- Weanling beside a mare does not count toward combination total.
- Horses are over 58", Ponies are 58" and under. Official show heights will be determined in June.
- No stallions beyond foaling year may be stalled in the Junior Fair Horse Barn or entered in any Junior Fair classes.
- Exhibitors must complete a Livestock Entry Form **and** a Horse Class Entry Form for each horse.
- Exhibitors entering posters must complete a Livestock Entry Form and indicate "poster."
- The premium an exhibitor receives will be based on the grade their animal receives in the show ring.

### Helmet Requirement

Junior Fair members (4-H, FFA) age 19 and under are required to wear a helmet when riding on the fairgrounds. Helmets are recommended for everyone.

### Dress Code

Exhibitors must follow the "Attire described in the Uniform Rules for 4-H Horse Shows," available from the Extension Office.

### Check-in, Stalling, and Exhibiting

- Horses may be brought to the Fairgrounds from 12:00 p.m. (noon) on Sunday, September 9 until 9:00 p.m. on Monday, September 10.
- Sawdust bedding for all Junior Fair horses and ponies will be provided by the Wyandot County Horse Committee. There will be a mandatory \$10.00 charge **per horse** which will be collected by 4-H/FFA advisors at the time Junior Fair entries are completed. Payment must be received to show.
  - No sawdust or straw bedding brought in by Junior Fair exhibitors will be permitted.
- All Junior Fair horses and ponies must be stalled on the fairgrounds for the duration of the Fair.
- No horses or ponies are permitted outside the immediate area of the Junior Fair Horse barn during the Fair. Horses should be in the barn, wash rack, or arena at all times.
- The Junior Fair Horse Arena will be closed and locked from 12:00 a.m. (midnight) to 6:00 a.m.

### Health Requirements

In addition to state health regulations, the following health regulations will be enforced by the local Fair Board upon recommendation of Wyandot County Veterinarians:

- A Certificate of Vaccination is required and must be presented to the Horse Department Advisors prior to the fair.
- An Equine influenza vaccination must be given between March 1 and August 31 of 2018.
- The Rhinopneumonitis vaccination is to be given at the discretion of the horse's owner.
