Judging will be held on Monday, June 24, 2019 at the Wyandot County Fairgrounds beginning at 4:00 p.m. You can sign up on 4-H Online for a time to be judged or call the Extension Office for a time. If you have more than one project please allow at least 15-20 minutes between projects. There will be signs in the buildings to direct you to your judging area.

Judging Procedure

Arrive before your scheduled time and come directly to the check-in/information area in the Dining Hall to find out the location of your project judging and registration procedures.

Projects will be judged at the discretion of the Judge if a member is excessively late.

After being judged, bring your score sheet to the grading table to be recorded and receive your ribbon.
